



FINALIST MODE

Finalist Mode is when a Driver reaches or surpasses 160 points. Multiple Drivers can have Finalist Mode at the same time. Points are still counted, even if Drivers are in Finalist Mode.

The first Driver to win a race on Major Day 2, while in Finalist Mode, is the Driver Champion of the ESL R1 2023 Spring Season. This means there will be a minimum of 4 races on Major Day 2 before a champion can be crowned.

In the example below the Driver placed 1st went into Major Day 2 as the leader and had his point transformed to 100 points. The Driver managed to win the first 3 races (25 points for each race) and has now 175 points as the points are added to his new transformed points. He is now in Finalist Mode meaning that he only needs to win one more race to become the champion.

If the Driver placed 2nd wins a race, he will now have 173 points and be in Finalist Mode as well. Now one of the two Drivers just needs to win a race.
